

Rules, Codes of Conduct & Supervision

Top Class Sport will endeavour to try to fulfil all requirements of those involved with our programmes/courses in order that every person has a full and enjoyable experience.

However, the company reserves the right to exclude or refuse any person at any time prior to or during the activity or course if, in the company's opinion, that person's behaviour prevents other clients from being able to participate with full enjoyment. In this instance the company will not provide a refund for any cost.

Top Class Sport staff provide full on and off site supervision and care. For residential camps the staff are accommodated in rooms within the same complex and they are accessible during the night.

Children sleep in single, twin rooms or dormitories. Should you wish you can make requests for rooming allocation and suggest other campers you might like to share with.

Please note that while we will do our best to comply with your wishes we are unable to guarantee that your request will be met.

Campers are responsible for any damage they may cause.

Top Class Sport Rules

All participants and their parents/guardians, where applicable, must be aware of these rules and agree to them. Failure to abide by these rules may result in a participant being sent home.

1. No alcohol, drugs or smoking
2. No anti-social behaviour either physical or mental
3. No-one is allowed to be in another person's room without prior permission for those on a residential course.
4. No participant on a Top Class Sport camp is allowed to leave the centre at any time either unaccompanied and/or without the prior permission from a member of staff on the programme.

7. Any areas of concern must be relayed to the senior staff on the programme immediately.
